PICK THE RIGHT TREE "If you like a tall tree the Fraser Fir has a tailored shape that won't take up too much width and the short needles hold up well to heavy ornaments. A Pine is a good choice for a country tree. The branches and needles are softer and longer which is very pretty, it's just a bit trickier to hang ornaments on as it's fluffier."

LET THERE BE LIGHT "The most important thing is getting your lights right. They're the foundation of a beautiful tree. You want your tree to twinkle from the inside out, so don't just drape strands on the outer branches. My trick is to wrap each branch in lights from the inside towards the outside."
